Dear Parents & Caregivers,

As we near the end of Week 6 it is interesting to note your children have only had about 14 days at school this year! Let's hope we don't lose any more days.

The recent weather and lower sun in the sky is telling us that the end of summer is fast approaching. Please make sure you send your children to school with some warm clothing just in case we get caught with one of those cold patches or days.
