Dear parents & caregivers,

Welcome to Week 7. The Term is now flying by with a lot to get done before the end of Week 10.

Mid-year progress reports for your children are currently being written by your children's classroom teacher. These are due to be sent home with your child on Monday 5 July. We will be having Parent/Child/Teacher Learning Conversations in Week 2 of Term 3. These will be on Wednesday 4 August from 2pm to 7pm and Thursday 5 August from 3.30pm to 6.00pm. You will receive information about booking these in due course, but keep a note of the dates and book early.

The fencing work around the school is still ongoing and has unfortunately been delayed due to some technical changes needed and also the weather. Thank you so much for your patience particularly with the main entrance at Onewa and Lake Roads being closed.

The wet weather we have been having has caused a number of issues around the school, not least being mud! We are trying to prevent your children getting to areas that are very muddy as best we can.
