Principal's Pen

Dear parents & caregivers

Welcome back to Week 2 of Term 3. I hope you all managed to have some relaxing and fun times with your children, friends and family. The weather has certainly been challenging lately and I am sure like you, my fingers are crossed for some nice weather to return soon.

You should hopefully have received information about this years board elections. A reminder the closing date for nominations is noon this Wednesday 3 August. Our school board election is set down for 7 September 2022. Please consider nomination for the board election by Wednesday if you have an interest in school governance.

Please make sure you take a look at the SchoolTV site (link at the bottom of the school website). There is a plethora of information and helpful topics in it, and it is free to use. This site is funded by Northcote Community of Learning | Kāhui Ako Lion Foundation grant so please use this resource while we have it.

We are currently looking at options to make safe a manhole cover that is situated by the drop-off bay in Nutsey Avenue. The cover is on a gravel area that is used as a shortcut down to the pool entrance and school gates. Recently a parent slipped on the manhole cover and was injured as a result. The concrete ramp that was installed during the new block build, is steep and slippery in the wet and we are looking at fitting some anti-skid strips to this. Our caretaker has placed warning tape by the manhole cover so please be aware of this and do not walk on it when wet in particular.

The board agreed to a garden upgrade to gardens that were frankly an eyesore and problematic keeping weed free. These are mainly the garden between the admin block and the tiger turf courts and also one running parallel to the staff carpark. Work is underway to replace these gardens. This will only enhance the environment around the school and is already looking great.

I have been asked to remind parents and caregivers to please maintain physical distancing when waiting for your children after school. Please consider others when you may find yourself congregating in a highly congested area such as the gates to school. Thank you for helping keep everyone as safe as possible.

Next week we have parent/child/teacher meetings on Wednesday and Thursday. Today we will send out a message on the school app so those who wish, or need to have an online 15 minute Zoom interview with your child's teacher can choose this option. Individual teachers will send a Zoom link for your interview if you choose, and this will still be at the same time you have booked on the school interview site. Teachers will be asking for confirmation from you if you will opt for an online interview rather than traditional face-to-face so they know whether to expect you in class or connect online.
