Principal's Pen

Dear parents & caregivers

I hope you are all making the most out of the change in the weather. What a nice start to autumn, it's just a shame summer didn't play ball like this. Thank you for sending your children to school with their hats until the end of Term 1. In Term 2 and 3 hats are optional.

In Term 4 2022 we had to have our 38-year-old schoolwide PA/Intercom system replaced. At the time we had three pairs of speakers fitted externally for outdoor use. Sadly, sometime in January this year the speakers were stolen. Some daring thieves climbed high and removed the speakers. The disappointing thing is we now must foot the bill to have them replaced. We will be reassessing where the company placed the speakers to make sure they are not as accessible as they were. The board approved the installation of three more CCTV cameras to help us monitor activity outside of school hours around the school. Signs will be installed to advise of CCTV coverage, as they are by the pump track. The three cameras recently installed focus on outdoor areas such as the Tiger Turf courts and hall, concrete courtyard and playground area by the new block and pool, and along the tree area between Kauri and Totara blocks.

We are still waiting for the installation of the artificial turf on the lower field. This has been a frustrating exercise and I am hopeful that the turf will be installed in the April school holidays. It will give a relatively large area adjacent to the playground closest to Lake Road, that can be used in all-weather as well as the grass fields during drier months.

Finally, a special request for anyone in our school community who uses the light controlled pedestrian crossing down Lake Road from our school by Sealy Beds. We have recently heard of several 'dangerous crossing' incidents at this crossing. While there are lights to aid crossing safely, please talk to your children about the fact they must still look carefully to ensure cars have stopped before they start to cross. Reinforce that just because the 'green' crossing figure comes on, it doesn't mean cars will stop. If you are crossing with your children, please also set a good example by walking bikes and scooters across and keeping a very close eye on your children and the surrounding traffic. This also applies to the crossing outside the school on Onewa Road.

Take care and stay safe.
