## Principal's Pen

Dear parents & caregivers,

As we approach the school holiday break, the sunshine today kind of makes us hopeful for some settled weather over the break. I hope you get some quality time with your children and family over the break.

Please take a look at the upcoming board election information that has been sent out by CES – the company running our mid-term elections. There are two positions which when elected, will start a three-year cycle. At last years board elections our board started a split cycle with three positions being three-years and two initially being 18 months. This means moving forwards we will not potentially have the whole board up for re-election at the same time. This is great for stability and ensuring an ongoing experience factor that a straight three-year cycle precludes.

We have been able to open the fields again now which is awesome for your children to have more space to run around and burn off some energy during break times. During the second week of the school holiday break outdoor grip carpet will be installed on the decking of the Village classrooms (Room 21 & 22 on the field). We hope with warmer weather we will move on with less of this affecting the school.

# **Out of Zone enrolments**

### Northcote Primary School Enrolment Scheme 2024

The enrolment at Northcote Primary School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on the school website. The board has determined that five Out of Zone places will be offered to new entrant students only. The deadline for receipt of applications for out of zone places is 15 October 2023. If a ballot for out of zone places is required, it will be held on 30 October 2023.

Parents of students who live within the home zone and intend enrolling their children at any time during the next year, should notify the school as soon as possible to assist the school in planning appropriately for 2024.
