Dear Parents

Welcome to the final NewsSheet for Term 2. It has been a packed and busy Term with a lot of things going on in a nine week term. We hope you all manage to have some quality time with family and friends over the term break.

Last week's Matariki event was a wonderful way to include family and whānau in the event with your children. Thank you to everyone who came in early to help make this event so special. A very special thanks to all our staff who planned and prepared for this event. It was a big undertaking and made special by the hours of work put into it before the day and during the day.

Parent/Child/Teacher conferences are scheduled for Week 2 of Term 3. These can be booked on Hero and will be available to be booked from the end of Term 2. Should you wish to have an online meeting you should still book a slot on Hero and advise the classroom teacher by email.

Property Update

During the term break our school buildings and roofs will be washed as part of our cyclical maintenance programme. We also have a project that will see the walkway between the Admin building and the Kauri block surfaced with ply and carpet. This will mean the walkway will be much quieter, warmer and feel like an inside walkway rather than a decking one. This project will also be applying slip resistant coating to the decking area leading up to the walkway entrance (Lake Road entrance), along the wooden walkway beside the Kauri block and also to the decking area outside Room 16. The application of this is however weather dependent so may be done following the school break on weekends if not able to be completed during the break. A second project will also hopefully be completed to replace broken windows in two Totara classes (Room 17 and Room 18). If the windows are ready this will occur in the second week of the break. It will involve scaffolding being erected on the field side of the rooms and also a section of the covered walkway outside Room 18 being removed so the windows can be installed, then replaced. This project is dependent on the window manufacturers having the windows ready, and the weather. Also as part of this project the Room 10 & 11 toilets will also have the upper open louvre 'windows' replaced by opening glass covered windows. These toilets get flooded during heavy rain. When these projects are being done there will be cones and tape in certain places so please respect the boundaries in place should you and your children be using the school grounds.
